2009 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ARTISTS

1. Artists agree to occupy exhibit space as assigned, and to be open and staffed during all regular Stroll hours. The Artists also agrees not to sublet or apportion to anyone else said space or to employ sales agents in lieu of himself or herself at the festivals.
2. Historically returning artists have priority for the Stroll in future years, however the artists agree that if accepted by the Stroll Art Selection Committee, into the 2009 Woodland Historic Stroll that Stroll is under no obligation to rent space to Artists in future years.
3. Insurance, if desired by artists, must be obtained by him or her at their own expense. The Stroll assumes no risk; and by the acceptance of this agreement, the artists expressly releases the Woodland Stroll Through History of and from any and all liability for any damage, injury, theft, or loss to any person or goods which may arise from the rental and occupation of said space by the artists.
4. The Stroll will not be liable for refunds or any other liabilities whatsoever for fire or other calamity, or by any act of God, public enemy, strikes, statutes, ordinances, or any legal authority, or any other cause beyond the Stroll control.
5. All exhibits must be designed, constructed and operated in good taste and in accordance with the best interest of the Woodland Stroll Through History, which Stroll Art Committee in its sole discretion shall have the right to decide. All sales, publicity and promotion activities conducted by the Artists must be confined to his or her space. Carnival tactics and the use of a public address system are forbidden.
6. AT THE 2009 STROLL: (1) ALL ARTICLES FOR SALE MUST BE MADE BY THE ART ARTISTS. (2) NO SALES REPRESENTATIVES ARE ALLOWED. (3) NO ITEMS BOUGHT OR OTHERWISE OBTAINED FROM A NONARTISTS ARE ALLOWED TO BE RESOLD BY THE ART ARTISTS.
7. These Terms and Conditions plus the Application for Exhibit Space constitute the entire CONTRACT between the parties, the Stroll Art Committee and Artists, and no waivers, modifications or amendments shall be valid unless written upon or attached hereto AND shall be approved in writing by a member of the Stroll Art Committee.
