

Title: The Stroll Through History Presents Vintage Fashion Follies

Woodland's "Stroll *Through* History" returns in its usual format in 2012. Meanwhile, the Stroll organizing committee is promoting events to keep the "Spirit of the Stroll" alive.

Our first event is called the Vintage Fashion Follies. This event will be held on September 11, 2010 at the Woodland Methodist Church. (Please note: This is a venue change from the Woodland Opera House). Save the date!!

This is not your "grandmother's" fashion show. Jeff Nauer, will emcee a series of entertaining skits. Each skit will dramatize a colorful era between 1849 and the present. Actors in authentic and/or reproduction costumes will re-create historic and fictional events during California's and Woodland's history. About 40 volunteer participants will model nearly 100 costumes.

Vintage Fashion Follies is organized by Sandy Biers, owner of Crickets Creative Apparel. Her company is a small business in Woodland that makes vintage fashion reproductions and re-furbishes heirloom clothing.

Vintage fashions are a hot new hobby. Interest in vintage fashions and vintage fashion shows has grown dramatically over the last 10 years. One example is the Vintage Fashion Expo, which is held on five weekends each year, alternating between San Francisco or Santa Monica, California. Their website lists over 100 vendors and attracts thousands of participants each year.
